 - Video Editing: Quarter1 10%, Quarter2 10% Final (5 projects) 80%
- c. Lincoln Lutheran's standard grade scales will be used.

4. Three Strikes:

- a. The Stick: Occasionally students find it hard to remain on task when seated in front of a computer. The first two times you are not on task will result in a warning. The third and any subsequent occurrences will result in lowering your final grade by 10 percentage points.
- b. The Carrot: There will be several periods of time when we are working on our large projects in class for multiple days. If you are sufficiently far along in your project, you may use either of your "freebies" to work on another school related activity.
