- ☐ Internal comments often used to explain parts of code.
- ☐ Internal comments are before code that is being explained.
- ☐ Blank line exist between procedures
- ☐ Line(s) do not "wrap" around to the left side.
- ☐ Procedure(s) do not span more than one page.
- ☐ Variables are all inCamelCase
- ☐ Variable names are all descriptive and easy to understand.
- ☐ Procedures have underscores_between_words.
- ☐ Procedures names describe what the procedures do well.
